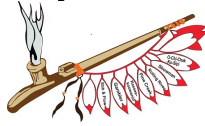

Under the supervision of the Jordan's Principle Services Coordinator and in accordance with WRT 2&4HS Mission, Values, Goals, Policies and Procedures, the Speech Language Pathologist will work as a member of the West Region Jordan's Principle Team. The Speech Language Pathologist will work with West Region Community Jordan's Principle Community based teams. The Speech Pathologist will provide services including programming, therapeutic interventions, consultative services and assessment.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Collaboration with all healthcare providers and community agencies who are involved with the child
- Provides community-based services like workshops, presentations and team building activities focused on developing and enhancing skills and capacity of frontline workers.
- Proactively builds front-line and community relationships to bring children and families with complex care needs to the right organizations and expedite assessments and referrals within all areas of the health care system.

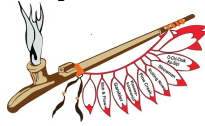
