



September 2020 Council Meeting Highlights

Council thoroughly reviewed and approved the CETP Exam and Registration Policy as presented by Registrar/Executive Director, S. Gordon.

Registrar/Executive Director, S. Gordon will continue to investigate and pursue the Cross Jurisdictional Practice project.

Council accepted the 2021 budget as presented.

The Registrar's performance review is in progress and a date has been chosen for this review with the Registrar/Executive Director, S. Gordon .

The Council President, F. Gaudry provided an update on a registration appeal and the status of the appeal .

College staff sent out a distribution email, to the CASLPM membership on August 28th, 2020, requesting volunteers for committee service to fill the position of an SLP on the Inquiry Committee. As of this date, there were no SLP submissions for this position.

Council determined it would be best to review the strategic plan based upon the educational workshop provided by our Governance Consultant, S. Tanchak who will lead a strategic planning day in early 2021.

The By-Law and Policy Review Committee met on June 23rd, 2020 and reviewed the new format for by-laws shared by public representative, C. Brown.

The Guidance for Practising During a Pandemic document has been completed, circulated to the registrants, and is available on the CASLPM website.

Council President, F. Gaudry thanked Registrar/Executive Director, S. Gordon for creating a Council evaluation tool. Council decided that the evaluation would consist of 'Thoughts from Council' after the next meeting, which would include a verbal conversation.
