

March 2022 Council Meeting Highlights

The College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Manitoba protects and serves the public by regulating and ensuring competent, safe, ethical practice of audiologists and speech-language pathologists in Manitoba. At every regular Council meeting, the Registrar and President report on operations of the College and correspondence with local and national regulatory bodies. The financial condition of the College is reviewed and discussed, and all committee chairs provide updates on committee work. Statutory Committees are the Complaints Investigation Committee, the Inquiry Committee, and the Continuing Competency Committee. Standing Committees such as the Practice Advisory Committee and ad hoc committees or working groups (created as needed) also give regular updates.

Decisions Pertaining to Registrants as of March 19, 2022

- The policy: Compliance of the Continuing Competency Program has been drafted by the Continuing Competency Committee, reviewed by legal counsel, and accepted by Council

Items of Note to Registrants as of March 19, 2022

- Sukhmeet “Suki” Kaur was hired as Deputy Registrar in March 2022
- Progress on the new website has been slower than anticipated. In connection with recent changes in staffing, the website working group has agreed to postpone launching a new website until the new staff better familiarize themselves with the website needs of the College.
- In the coming months, a jurisprudence module will be available for registrants to complete as part of continuing competency requirements.
- The Practice Advisory Committee continues to work on practice directions for Informed Consent and Advertising
