

## Council Meeting Highlights June 11, 2022

The College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Manitoba protects and serves the public by regulating and ensuring competent, safe, ethical practice of audiologists and speech-language pathologists in Manitoba. At every regular Council meeting, the Registrar and President report on operations of the College and correspondence with local and national regulatory bodies. The financial condition of the College is reviewed and discussed, and all committee chairs provide updates on committee work. Statutory Committees are the Complaints Investigation Committee, the Inquiry Committee, and the Continuing Competency Committee. Standing Committees such as the Practice Advisory Committee and ad hoc committees or working groups (created as needed) also give regular updates.

Decisions Pertaining to Registrants as of June 11, 2022

Items of Note to Registrants as of June 11, 2022

- There is a vacancy for a non-Council SLP on the Continuing Competency Committee. Registrants can apply to sit on a CASLPM committee at any time during the year.
- A survey will be sent to registrants for input on a draft Advertising Practice Direction.
- Renewals will open in September (rather than October as in past years) to allow for extra time to complete the Jurisprudence Module. Renewal deadline (without penalty) is October 31, 2022
