Who Can Attend a Council Meeting?

College Council meetings are open to the public. Anyone who wishes to observe a Council meeting is welcome to do so.

Space is limited; if you wish to attend an upcoming meeting, please register with the CASLPM Office (<u>office@caslpm.ca</u>) at least 5 business days prior to the meeting date to confirm your attendance.

Meetings of Council are open to for public observation; there may be times during a meeting when the Council must consider a matter in confidence. Council then rises as a council and sits as a Committee of the Whole to consider matters related to complaints, investigation, and discipline proceedings, personnel, or other confidential subjects.

Meeting Details

Meetings are held virtually, or in the Council Chambers of the College Office, 112B Scurfield Blvd., Winnipeg MB.

Meetings begin at 9:00 a.m. and typically end around 4:00 p.m. with morning and afternoon refreshment breaks, and a 45-minute break at lunch.

Who Can Speak at Council Meetings?

Participation in the meetings is limited to Council members and staff of the College.

Registrants of the College, the public, representatives of the media, or any other individual may not speak to issues or ask questions during the business session.

If you have an issue to bring forward for consideration by Council, please contact the Registrar prior to the meeting to make arrangements.

- Refrain from talking once the meeting is called to order.
- If you must leave or enter the Council chambers while the meeting is underway, do so quietly.
