1. International Application Assessments

The office has resumed the assessment of internationally trained applicants completed by the Canadian Alliance of Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology Regulators (CAASPR) for the past several years. CASLPM will recruit assessors from the professions of audiology and speech-language pathology as needed in the future.

Items of Interest

1. Application Review Committee ("ARC")

The ARC committee was constituted by Council on August 21, 2023 and will be tasked with reviewing internationally educated applicants who have major gaps in training (e.g. do not possess an equivalent master's level degree in either profession) and minor gaps where a resolution is not immediately found by the CASLPM office (e.g. missing clinical hours or coursework). The recruitment for this committee will take place before January 2024 and the ARC will meet every other month as needed to review applications from internationally educated applicants.
