Items of Note to Registrants as of April 22, 2024

Practice Directions Update

- The Practice Advisory Committee (“PAC”) is modifying the Guidance for Telepractice to a Practice Direction on Virtual Practice.
- The Supervision Practice Direction will be provided to registrants for feedback via survey once approved by Council.

CASLPM Strategic Focus for 2024

- CASLPM has concluded the bulk of operational strategic items from the 2019 strategic planning sessions. As a result, Council is working towards a new term of items for short- to long-term focus.
- CASLPM Council has determined strategic focus items via a SWOT (strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, threats) analysis, multiple surveys to garner information, and a ranking of priorities during the April council meeting.
- Council will begin focusing on strategic focus items, operational strategy, and tactics for each strategic item in the upcoming meetings.
- There may be opportunities for registrants to join working groups to work on specific items over the next short- to mid-term.
