This may involve a formal complaint to the Complaints Investigation Committee, as Registrants have an obligation to complete Continuing Competency as outlined in the *Regulated Health Professions Act* (RHPA) Section 87(1) and the CASLPM General Regulations 192/2013 Part 6.
