POLICY TITLE: Access Issues

The Registrar shall address issues related to access to the profession in accordance with this policy within the limits of the resources available for this purpose.

Accordingly, the Registrar shall:

1. Inform the government, employers, universities, members of the College, and/or the public, on the need for the services that members of the College provide.
2. Inform the government, employers, insurers, members of the College, and/or the public, on barriers to access with respect to barriers that prohibit members of the College from providing services within their scope of practice; but not with respect to funding barriers.
3. Take steps to inform employers about the standards of practice and members' responsibilities to meet those standards.
4. Support consumer groups and professional associations in their requests for additional services by supplying information about the role and responsibilities of members of the College.
