POLICY TITLE: Treatment of Members

The Registrar shall treat members in accordance with the provisions of the *Regulated Health Professions Act* ("RHPA") and College regulations, and with a level of courtesy and respect which is reasonably expected in common business practice.

Accordingly, the Registrar shall:

- 1. Use application forms that elicit only information which is clearly necessary.
- 2. Use methods of collecting, reviewing, transmitting, or storing information that protect against improper access to the information elicited.
- 3. Maintain facilities that provide a reasonable level of privacy, both aural and visual.
- 4. Ensure reasonable access to CASLPM by people with special physical, language, financial, emotional, or other needs.
- 5. Provide a mechanism for the regular communication of Council and College business to registrants.
- 6. Take reasonable steps to communicate individual rights under the RHPA and College regulations to potential, current, and past registrants.
- 7. Inform members about their professional responsibilities and the consequences of non-compliance.
