POLICY TITLE: Health Profession Corporation

Purpose

The Regulated Health Professions Act ("RHPA") gives members of the College the ability to carry on practice of the profession of audiology or speech-language pathology, whichever the case may be, as a Health Profession Corporation.

This policy serves to outline the establishment of a Health Profession Corporation and the Health Profession Corporation Record.

Policy

The Registrar shall:

- 1. Establish and manage a Health Profession Corporation and the Health Profession Corporation Record in accordance with all applicable legislation, by-laws, and policy.
- 2. Accept application from a registrant for an initial permit or renewal of a permit for a Health Profession Corporation upon receipt of the following documentation:
 - a. Health Profession Corporation Permit Application form, Appendix A
 - b. Corporation Certification form, Appendix B
- 3. Upon review of the documentation, take one of the following actions:
 - a. Approve the permit or renewal without conditions
 - b. Approve the permit or renewal with conditions
 - c. Refuse to issue the permit or renewal
- 4. If the permit or renewal is approved, provide an invoice to the member for all applicable fees, as prescribed in CASLPM by-laws, Schedule 2: Fees.
- 5. Upon payment of all applicable fees by the member, issue the permit or renewal; the permit shall be in effect for one year.
- 6. Upon issuing the permit, enter the required information onto the Health Profession Corporation registry.
- 7. Receive notification of any changes to the corporation. Changes may pertain to: voting shares, shareholders, directors and officers of the corporation.
 - Such notice must be reported to the Registrar by submitting the Change in Particulars form, Appendix C.
