Committee Matters

Practice Advisory Committee (PAC)

The Practice Advisory Committee has completed the update of the Telepractice Guideline to a Virtual Practice Practice Direction and has notified registrants of the change in documents. It is available on the CASLPM website and will take effect on April 1, 2025.

The Supervision Practice Direction and accompanying guidelines for audiologists and speech-language pathologists were distributed to Registrants via survey on January 23, 2025. The PAC will review and revise the PD as deemed necessary, seek approval from Council, and anticipates rollout to take place in early summer 2025 for implementation in fall 2025.

The PAC continues to work on the following guidelines:

- Guideline on Interprofessional Collaboration of Public and Private Practitioners (research).
- Guideline on Diagnosis (research).
