Items of Note to Registrants as of February 8, 2025

Referrals to Otolaryngologists (ENT) by Audiologists

Council agreed that the Practice Advisory Committee should develop guidelines for referrals to ENT by audiologists.

Indigenous Cultural Safety Jurisprudence Module

The Manitoba Alliance of Health Regulators has developed a jurisprudence module for all alliance members. CASLPM Council reviewed the module and approved the rollout for mandatory completion by the 2027 (October 31, 2026) renewal period.

Practice Advisory Committee (PAC)

Feedback on the supervision practice direction and guidelines was reviewed and incorporated into the documents. The council directed that guidelines for responsible use of artificial intelligence as a tool in practice be drafted.
