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### **Regulatory Matters**

#### *Complaints Investigation*

As of the writing of this report, one complaint has concluded, and one remains under review.

#### *Cultural Safety Jurisprudence Module Rollout*

The Manitoba Alliance of Health Care Regulators has created a jurisprudence module that was rolled out to registrants in August 2025. The mandatory module must be completed before renewal for 2027.

### **Committee Matters**

#### *Practice Advisory Committee (PAC)*

Registrants are reminded that the Supervision Practice Direction and accompanying guidelines for audiologists and speech-language pathologists will be implemented on September 2, 2025.

New guidelines for registrant feedback will be provided to registrants:

- Guidelines on Diagnosis (first draft presented to Council; feedback incorporated; second draft to be reviewed at August 16 meeting).
- Guidelines for Audiologists on Referral to Otolaryngology (first draft presented to Council; feedback incorporated, second draft to be reviewed at August 16 meeting).
- Guidelines on Responsible Use of AI (first draft presented to Council; feedback incorporated, second draft to be reviewed at August 16 meeting).

#### *Advanced Competency Working Group (ACWG)*

- The ACWG has completed drafting Guidelines on Dysphagia, which will be provided to registrants for feedback upon review and approval by Council.
