## Items of Note to Registrants as of November 22, 2025

### Council Application Process

Application packages for Council will be distributed by February 27, 2026.

Council will be seeking registrant members who have a willingness to learn about governance and regulatory obligations, openness to understanding Council and committee process, and who can demonstrate investment in participation on Council and committees. Registrants will be encouraged to apply from all cohorts and demographic groups. Experience in legal, IT, cybersecurity, and HR are considered assets.

### Practice Advisory Committee (PAC) Updates

Feedback and revisions to the following guidelines were reviewed and approved by Council for use by registrants:

- Guidelines on Audiologists Referral to Otolaryngologists
- Guidelines on Diagnosis
- Guidelines on Responsible Use of AI
- Clinical Framework on Dysphagia Management (previously Dysphagia Practice Guidelines)

Following feedback from registrants, the Practice Advisory Committee recommended updating the names of Advanced Competencies 1 and 2 by incorporating the term “Flexible” in place of “Fibreoptic.” Because the RHPA specifically uses the term “Fibreoptic,” Council approved adding “Flexible” in brackets to reflect current terminology. The Advanced Competencies are now titled:

1. Fibreoptic (Flexible) Endoscopic Evaluation and Management of Voice Disorders
2. Fibreoptic (Flexible) Endoscopic Evaluation and Management of Swallowing Disorders

Council will undertake a review of the College’s Code of Ethics.
