Complaints Investigation

Committee Matters

Practice Advisory Committee (PAC)

PAC is revising current and preparing new documents related to Standards of Practice. Over the upcoming months, changes will be made to the current CASLPM Practice Directions, Guidelines, and supporting documents that will reflect guidance from and review by the CASLPM Council to ensure that the changes incorporated are easy to reference and understand for registrants.

CASLPM looks forward to rolling out these revised documents during the year.

Continuing Competency Audit Penalty for Failure to Complete

The CASLPM Council approved a recommendation from the Continuing Competency Committee to assess a penalty for failure to complete continuing competency requirements. In 2026, the fee is \$50 with an increase to \$200 in 2027.

Registrants are encouraged to complete their self-assessment form in January each year and ensure that all competency requirements are met for their three-year period by December 31 of the final year. Failure to complete 45 hours of competency in a 3-year period will result in the fine being assessed.
