### Duties & Responsibilities (include but are not limited to):

- Assessment and consultation to determine treatment goals/programming.
- Experience with preschool, school age children and pre-teens this is the majority of the clientele seen in the centre.
- Liaise with families by way of support personnel to provide necessary updates to families on the progression of treatment goals and modify treatment goals as needed for subsequent treatment blocks.
- Work as part of a caring team of collaborative professionals which compliment communication disorders.
