

Introduction

This *Minimum Practice Hours Standard of Practice* outlines expectations for registrants when completing their five-year review and submissions of hours practiced to the College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Manitoba (CASLPM).

Standard

CASLPM registrants ensure that their claimed and documented practice hours are within the scope of the professions of audiology and speech-language pathology. Registrants are responsible for meeting the expectations outlined in this Standard and the accompanying guidelines.

Demonstrating the Standard

Registrants will:

- Engage in professional practice as indicated in the scope of practice for their profession.
- Have their practice hours assessed within the five-year period immediately before applying for renewal.
 - Have a minimum practice hour currency of 1250 hours within the previous five-year period.
 - Have at least 410 practice hours spent providing direct client service within the previous five-year period.
